FUNERAL OF GERRY BARKER

On January 5th in St Mary's Church Potton, we said a fond farewell to one of our oldest members. Gerry Barker was 91 but died suddenly after a fall and a short illness in December last year. He is pictured here with his lifelong friend, Ray Neal, both crew members on RAF Shackleton Coastal Command Patrols in the early 1950s during their National Service. Unfortunately, Ray was not able to make the journey from his home in Nottingham due to his own health issues. Over 100 people came to pay their respects and we were pleased to have a small Veteran's Guard of Honour from the Biggleswade Military Veterans Club and the British Legion in Church for the Service. A collection was taken for St John's Hospice, amounting to nearly £450. The reception was held at the John O'Gaunt Golf Club where Gerry had been a member.
