#### Some Sad News

I'm afraid I must inform you that we have had a significant theft from St. Marys. The majority of our silverware has been taken from the safe including our most regularly used communion items and even the shell we use to baptise with.

I'm sure you will have lots of questions, but unfortunately there are still some things that we are uncertain about We do know that the theft took place on 27 January between 12:40 and 3.50pm while the church was open.

We have of course informed the police, our insurers and the Archdeacon who sends his thoughts and prayers. As I write Scene of Crime Officers are looking round the church, but I am not confident we will recover the silverware. We have looked through the CCTV that St. Marys House have and they will of course give the footage to the police. I thank them for their assistance in this matter.

Going forward It would be prudent if we could have a full log of who has what key. Can I ask to let Hazel know what keys you have and she can record this. This will help when we begin changing locks etc.

The church will be locked until we can get some of the internal locks **changed.** Those who need to access the church are asked to speak to key holders

It is worth us remembering that we do not know the circumstances of the person who has taken these items. This may have been done from a place of desperation or simply not having better prospects then carer criminality. Indeed I bid you pray for him.
