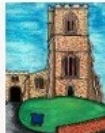
## Jim Seamer

We have used the money from the insurance payout to buy these, but we have also had a generous offer from the Deborah and Simon Royal as part of their 35th Wedding Anniversary. Together they have bought one of our replacement chalices.

Unfortunately a few of the items are taking awhile to be sent to our supplier. Therefore the set's first outing won't be till Sunday 11th February.

We still need help in two key ways:

**1. Volunteers to Cook and Serve the Meal!**

To show hospitality and make attendance easier for people coming from work, we would like to be able to serve food. This would be precooked and then reheated. The meal only needs to be something simple like soup. (We will not know dietary requirements till after the first session, so we suggest vegetarian/ dishes). You would then bring the food and help serve it on the night. A sign up sheet is available on the welcome desk at the North Door entrance and **there are still three sessions we need cooks for.**

**2. Invite people to attend!**
