REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY IN POTTON

Please remember there is no 10:30 service at St. Marys Church.

The Potton Remembrance Day Service and Parade, will assemble in the Market Square from 10am for a 10.10am start. The short service will be traditional prayers and hymns before forming into a procession to Parade, led by the Salvation Army, to the Cemetery in Sandy Road, where Wreathes will be laid on the War Memorial and the names of the Fallen Sons of Potton will be remembered. At 11am, after the Last Post is sounded, the Two Minutes Silence will be observed followed by the Reveille. After final prayers, the Parade will then return to the Market Square.

REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY IN SUTTON & COCKAYNE HATLEY

There are services in both churches at 9am which will include a moment of remembrance. Sutton's service will be taken by our friend Rev. Barbra Ebeling while Cockayne Hatley's will be taken by Rev. Alex Wheatley. The services should finish before 10am allowing people to get to whichever 11am commemoration they wish to go to.
