Saturday 6 May: Coronation Day

There will be a number of activities and places around the town, that will be venues to watch the Coronation on big screens, including St. Marys and All Saints in Sutton! The timings for the churches are as follows:

0930: Churches open.

1000: Procession: Buckingham Palace to Westminster Abbey

1100: The Coronation Service. Following the service, there will be a Celebration Drink, served in the Church.

1200: Procession: Westminster Abbey to Buckingham Palace

After the Balcony Appearance and Flypast, the church hall and field, will be available for all who have brought a picnic. Please do not consume any food in the church, but use the hall and field facility afterwards. Tea and Coffee will be served in the hall.

There will of course be no charge by the churches for this event, **HOWEVER** attendees are strongly encouraged to bring something to donate into our **Preen Food Collection as they arrive.** This will be a prayerful acknowledgment amidst the this historic day that times are tough for many people.

What Is It?

Thy Kingdom Come (TKC) is a global ecumenical prayer movement that invites Christians around the world to pray from Ascension to Pentecost for more people to come to know Jesus.

How Will We Be Taking Part?

St. Marys will be teaming up with our friends at Salvation Army Potton.

The week will begin with a united **Ascension Day service** at 7:30pm on 18 May at St. Marys with our friends from the Salvation Army.

Then at each evening that follows there will be a service of **Evening** Prayer at 6.30pm using material produced for Thy Kingdom Come. These will alternate between St. Marys and the Salvation Army Chapel in the following configuration:

Friday 19 May: Salvation Army Saturday 20 May: St. Mary Sunday 21 May: Salvation Army

Monday 22 May: St. Mary

Tuesday 23 May: Salvation Army Wednesday 24 May: St. Mary Thursday 25 May: Salvation Army

Friday 26 May: St. Mary

Saturday 27 May: Salvation Army

The period will then end with a united Pentecost service at 6pm on Sunday 28th May at the Salvation Army Chapel (morning services run as normal.)

In addition, our Sunday Morning services on 21 May and the Shine Together Service on 25 May will both have Thy Kingdom Come as their theme.

What About a Personal Practice?

There are all sorts of things you could do:

- Download the Thy Kingdom Come App and use it each day.
- Choose three people in your life and commit to praying each day that they might come closer to the faith and Jesus.
- Use this as an opportunity to explore new prayer practices such as the Orthodox Jesus Prayer, Jesuit Examen or Contemplative Prayer.

We strongly encourage you to participate however you can. Do ask Rev. Alex for more details.
