REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY IN POTTON

November 12th 2023

The Potton Remembrance Day Service and Parade, assemble in the Market Square from 10am for a 10.10am start. The short service will be traditional prayers and hymns before forming procession to Parade, led by the Salvation Army, Cemetery Sandy in where Wreathes will be laid on the War Memorial and the names of the Fallen Sons of Potton will be remembered. At 11am, after the Last Post is sounded, the Two Silence be observed followed by the Reveille.

After final prayers, the Parade will then return to the Market Square.
