Potton Parish Lunch Annual Presentation to The Sue Ryder St John's Hospice Moggerhanger

The Potton Parish Lunch of January 27th 2023, was the occasion when the Cheque of the Proceeds of the 2022 Lunches was handed over to the Fund Raising Team from St John's.

This year the cheque was our largest ever and was for £5,500.

Ruth Norman handed the cheque to Nick Burr who went on to tell us that since we had started our scheme in 1993, we have raised a total of £88,685, an amount which could fund 4,223 hours of care for patients and their families in difficult times.

We are very pleased we were able to do this and help so many.
