Last weekend was a busy one in Potton and the surrounding districts.

On Saturday, in Potton we had the Annual Potton Show where all the artists, photographers, flower and vegetable growers, bakers and home brewers and hand crafters of all types, gathered together in a large marquee on the church field, to try and win top money in their relevant classes, or maybe a silver cup! A good crowd came along to see how skilled some of our townspeople are with their hands and maybe giving them ideas for the next Potton Show, a year from now. The weather was ideal and we were entertained throughout the afternoon by the very talented Letchworth Morris Men who come along every year to show their skills in this ancient form of folk dancing. As usual, they gave us enjoyment and amusement throughout the afternoon. In the evening, after all the exhibits were put away or given away as the case may be, the marquee was reset for a splendid session of barn dancing till late into the night. A great day all round! Sunday morning saw the next event, a Craft Fayre, being set up for Craft enthusiasts.

On Sunday, the day was a little different as it coincided with National Heritage day, a day looking at our Heritage and organised by the National Trust with various members of St Mary's Church and our sister churches in Sutton and Cockayne Hatley, and as well as attending their morning services, attended to the needs of walkers and bike riders who were visiting ancient churches in the two counties of Bedfordshire and Hertfordshire and this needed volunteers to log them into the tour locally and to see if they needed refreshments on a break in their journey. Other volunteers like myself, went a bit further perhaps, as I went to Jordan's Mill on the edge of Biggleswade to give my time showing visitors around various aspects of this ancient mill, which became the first water mill in the country to produce pure white flour, from 1900 onwards. All modern mills are based on the system derived at this unique mill but it no longer makes flour even though all the machinery is still in place, and it will never produce white flour again due to modern Food Safety rules. For me, it was a good chance to meet lots of people and tell them how their modern bread was developed, once pure white flour could be made. The Mill closed in 2000 having worked since 1900, but is now a popular visitor attraction in the area.
