The third goal of St. Marys Potton's Mission Action plan is:: "Get into a yearly habit of hosting an Enquirers Course"

An 'Enquirers Course' is a course specifically for those who are 'enquiring' about the Christian faith. They are for 'seekers' and those who are curious about the faith or are looking for the opportunity to think more deeply about life's big questions. Such courses are therefore a really part of contemporary mission and church growth. What's more although this is St. Marys Potton's goal, this course has the potential to benefit All Saints Sutton and St. John the Baptist Cockayne Hatley.

For St. Marys Potton's Enquirers Course Rev. Alex has chosen the 'Start!' Course. This is a wonderfully down to earth course which makes no assumptions about participants' background, experience or knowledge of Christianity. Though it is called a 'course' it is not formal, but light-hearted with an emphasis on sharing and listening.

The course will begin on Thursday 15th of February 2024 and continue on the following five Wednesdays. They will meet at 7pm in the Potton Community Centre (Brook End) for a meal before starting at 7.30pm. There are six sessions in total.

To make this courses happen we will need your help in two ways!:

Volunteers to Cook and Serve the Meal!

To show hospitality and make attendance easier for people coming from work we would like to be able to serve food. This would be precooked and then reheated.

You don't need to commit to all the weeks! If six people took one each that would cover us.

The meal only need be something simple like soup. (We will not know dietary requirements till after the first session, so we suggest vegetarian/ dishes) You would then bring the food and help serve it on the night. A sign up sheet is on the welcome desk at the back of church.

Invite people to attend!

We will be promoting this course at the Link Café, at Christmas Services and online, however by far the best way is to invite people personally. Perhaps you know someone who has been asking questions or you have a relative who is curious. If so be brave and invite them! (There are plenty of flyers available in church)

Taster Session

Of course it is hard to invite someone to something you have not experienced yourself before! This is why we will be running a taster session for congregation members on **11 January at 7.30pm in the Community Centre**
